

Marty Coulter One-Day Workshop

Ste. Genevieve MO September 20 2022

Please join us for my plein-air painting workshop at the Ste. Genevieve Art Center at 310 Merchant Street 63670 in scenic Ste. Genevieve, Missouri on Tuesday September 20th from 9:00 am - 4:00 pm. We'll start the morning indoors with a brief discussion of the materials and methods I use when painting the landscape on location. I'll create an 8"x10" demonstration painting in acrylic and oil with brushes and knife. We'll discuss the principles of preliminary sketching, doing a value study, making format decisions and using the brush and knife creatively. At 10:00 am we'll go outside, weather permitting, to set up and paint. If we must stay indoors, I'll bring plenty of photos to work from, or bring your own. I'll make the rounds to each artist for assistance as requested, with constructive comments and advice. After an hour break for lunch, we'll decide to either continue with our morning works, or choose a different location and start new paintings. Around 4:00 pm we'll review everyone's progress with my suggestions for improvements, and a Q & A session for any lingering problems.

The framed demo painting will be available for \$250.00.

The Supplies That I Use

- *Jack Richeson Italian Field Easel (Amazon)*
- *12" x 24" hand-made birch paint box with tempered glass mixing surface*
- *Hand-made sketch kit with index cards, ballpoint pen and 20%,40%,60% and 80% gray markers*
- *Shadebuddy Umbrella (Jerry's artarama)*
- *Folding Stool (Walmart)*
- *Backpack (yard sale) big enough to hold sketch kit, paints, solvent can, paper towels, trash bags, disposable gloves, bug spray, sun block, drinking water and snacks*
- *Daler-Rowney Georgian 225ml oil Titan.White, Cad.Yellow Lt., Scarlet Lake, Ult. Blue*
- *Liquitex Basics Acrylics 250ml Titan. White, Cad. Yellow Lt., Cad. Red. Med., Ult. Blue*
- *Pro Stroke Hog Bristle Flats set of six #2, #4, #6, #8, #10 and #12 plus #6 Liquitex free-style painting knife (Blick)*
- *Hand-made 1/8" and 1/4" baltic birch panels surfaced with either gesso or canvas*

My list is only a guide, don't feel that you need to buy what I use. Bring your favorite art supplies, but if you're new to painting outdoors, use my list as needed. If you prefer to use pastels or watercolor, you're welcome to join us. Although I'll be using acrylic and oil, I can still offer you advice on sketching, composition, value and color. Just bring along enough materials to create one or two small 8"x10" or 9"x12" paintings.

The workshop is \$150.00 for Ste. Gen. Art Guild members (non members are \$175) with a fully-refundable deposit of \$75.00 to hold your place. The remainder is paid on arrival. Enrollment is limited to 12 attendees to allow for ample instruction time for everyone.

My professional career spans more than five decades, beginning in the late sixties as an architectural illustrator in St. Louis. Hundreds of illustrations were created for local architects and builders in addition to many national and international projects such as Universal Studios, Sea World and a series for the Olympic Stadium in Barcelona Spain. I've been painting outdoors for 15 years and have garnered my share of local and national awards. I was fortunate to win Best of Show, Best Oil, People's Choice and Artist's Choice at the 2016 Augusta Plein Air Festival. I've participated in the Ste. Gen. Plein Air Event since 2012, and have taken home quite a few ribbons. I only teach a few workshops a year, so sign up today and join us this September in Ste. Genevieve!
